

'Arduous' fight for Killalea

THE community battle to save Killalea State Park from private development is going to be a long, arduous one, union representatives told a public meeting at Shell Cove last night.

Peter Zaboyak, the assistant secretary of the NSW branch of the construction division of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union said he hoped the interim green ban he had earlier this month slapped on development at the park, would turn into a community green ban.

"It's going to be a long haul, it's going to be a grind and I don't want anyone to give up," he said.
